The regular monthly City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Deborah Pinkerton after she declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. The financial report was presented by Treasurer Sandy Cook. End of March balances for each account were read and the April Financial Report was reviewed. A motion to approve the April Financial Report was made by Alderman Johnson and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 4-0

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Grounds Supervisor Kenneth Brenton reported that 90% of the roads have been graded and ditches dug out. Lawn care has been performed around City Hall and the park. A motion was made to purchase a blower for the Street Department by Alderman Breshears and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0

Police Chief Ken Howard reported 32 citizen calls, 2 assists to other agencies, 2 citations, 1 warning citation, 1 alarm answered, 2 accidents, 0 arrests, 2 felonies and misdemeanor reports filed, and 0 warrants served. Three code enforcement warnings were issued. Two new police cars have been placed in service, a third will be ready in a week and a fourth will be picked up within the next two weeks.

Fire Chief Cody Cooper reported 2 fire and 4 medical calls. Two additional volunteers have been added to the force. The recently purchased tanker is functional. The department has one pumper truck that did not pass the last inspection and will need replacing in the near future.
