CITY OF CEDARVILLE CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES July 16, 2019

The regular monthly City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Isenhower after he declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Council members present were Alderman McClendon, Alderman Breshears and Alderman Johnson. Alderman Odom was absent.

A motion to approve the June regular monthly meeting minutes was made by Alderman Breshears and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 3-0

The financial report was presented by Treasurer Sandy Cook. End of June balances for each account were read and the July Financial Report was reviewed. A midyear report (January through June) was presented. A motion to approve the July Financial Report was made by Alderman McClendon and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 3-0

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Grounds Supervisor Kenneth Brenton reported that the department has repaired sink holes in Lucian Wood Road and maintained the grounds as weather permitted. The department is seeking another part time employee to replace Logan Williams who has taken a full time position elsewhere. July 31st will be the last day for the current road grader operator.

Police Chief Ken Howard reported 26 citizen calls, 2 assists to other agencies, 17 citations, 13 warning citations, 0 alarms answered, 3 accidents, 3 arrests, 5 felonies and misdemeanor reports filed, 1 warrant served and 26 complaint reports. Chief Howard reported that Officer Michael Arellanes is leaving at the end of July.

Fire Chief Cody Cooper reported 6 calls since the previous council meeting. The recently acquired extraction equipment was used for the first time at the scene of an accident. Mayor Isenhower and Chief Cooper attended the Arkansas State Fire Convention. ISO rating requirements were discussed in detail. Chief Cooper is confident the City of Cedarville will maintain its current ISO rating of 4.
