RESOLUTION NO. 2018-10-16-1

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXCHANGE OF THE 1978 FIRE ENGINE FOR A 1993 FIRE ENGINE AND EQUIPMENT; ADJUSTING THE FIXED ASSET LIST; AND RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated a transaction for the trade of the City's current 1978 fire engine for a 1993 fire engine with equipment;

WHEREAS, the City's 1978 truck is obsolete and not capable of meeting the legal requirements for continued operation as a fire truck (i.e. exposed passenger compartments, inoperable pump) without great expenditure;

WHEREAS, the owner of the 1993 truck has determined that it's truck is surplus and wishes to acquire the 1978 truck for placement in a fire museum;

WHEREAS, the City of Cedarville would benefit greatly from the superior fire protection afforded by the 1993 truck.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CEDARVILLE, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** After intense scrutiny, careful consideration, and due diligence, it is the opinion of the City Council of Cedarville, Arkansas, that the 1978 fire engine has no value except as scrap metal and that the 1993 fire engine with equipment provides far greater fire protection benefits.

**SECTION 2:** The Cedarville City Council hereby authorizes the mayor to trade the 1978 fire engine described and identified as:

Cedarville Fire Department ENGINE 2, 1978 PEMFAB, VIN P764


for the 1993 fire engine and equipment described and identified as:

1993 E1 Pumper, VIN 4ENRAAA89P1002235

**SECTION 3:** Upon completion of the exchange, the 1978 fire truck shall be removed from the fixed asset list and the 1993 fire engine shall be added to the fixed asset list.
